

Guidelines for Works in Progress at the 2026 AEDEM Global Summit

The acceptance and subsequent submission of a *Work in Progress* must adhere to the following requirements:

1. Comply with the format of the *Work in Progress* template.
2. Provide a sufficiently detailed description of the *Design and Methodology* section of the study, as well as a section of *References* that support the state of the art of the subject of the research.
3. Develop the sections of the *Work in Progress* template with a maximum length of 2,000 words and a minimum of 1,500 words.
4. Send the completed template to the *Works in Progress* area of the Conference management platform.
5. The '*Work in Progress*' area, regardless of the thematic area, will bring together all research work not yet completed at the time of receiving proposals.
6. Three files will be uploaded to the platform: one with the template and the data of the authors, a second one with the anonymous template and a third file only with the Summary-Abstract and the authors' data.
7. The review of the work in progress will receive the corresponding evaluation: 'ACCEPTED' or 'NOT ACCEPTED'. No additional qualitative scores or evaluations will be given. The response will be 'NOT ACCEPTED' in cases where requirements 1, 2 and 3 are not fulfilled.
8. The presentation at the Conference must adhere to the development of the proposal specified in the template.
9. The 'hybrid' session in which the presentation of *Works in Progress* is programmed, will be a participative forum in which the attendees will exchange impressions and/or proposals for the research improvement.
10. No *Work in Progress* will be eligible for Awards.
11. Once presented at the Conference sessions, only the Abstract of the *Work in Progress* will be published in the Proceedings.
